

# Sharing Sad News – A Resource For Teachers and Parents Answering Questions from Children about Bella's Death



Tarra and Bella were adored by so many children. Children learned much from Tarra and Bella's example of loving and respecting one another, despite their differences. Now that Bella is gone, many may wonder and worry about Tarra, and have questions about Bella's death. It may make your child feel better to create a piece of artwork of Bella or to write Bella a letter on her <u>Tribute</u> page.

## How did Bella die?

Bella's vet, Dr. Scott, thinks Bella may have been killed by other animals, probably coyotes.

# Why didn't Tarra chase away the coyotes?

She may have been sleeping, or Bella might not have been with her when the coyotes first came. But we think she did find them and chase them away! Tarra was a very protective friend to Bella. She did her best to try and save her. After the accident, Tarra carried Bella back to the barn with her trunk.

## Don't you worry about the coyotes killing an elephant?

## Will The Elephant Sanctuary get another dog for Tarra?

Tarra might make friends with the other dogs we have at the Sanctuary. There are many she can choose from! But we hope and think that Tarra will become even closer and better friends with her elephant sisters. Elephants like Shirley, Sissy, and Winkie have all been spending lots of time with Tarra since Bella died. They are doing their best to make Tarra feel better.

### How is Tarra doing?

Tarra is sad, but her Caregivers are watching out for her. They have been checking on her a lot and feeding her favorite treats to try and cheer her up. Tarra's elephant sisters have been sharing with her, too, and reaching out to make her feel better.

#### Who will be Tarra's best friend now?

We think Shirley will, but Tarra has many other elephant friends, too, like Sissy and Winkie. We think becoming even better friends with Shirley will make Tarra feel better, even though she will always love and miss Bella!
